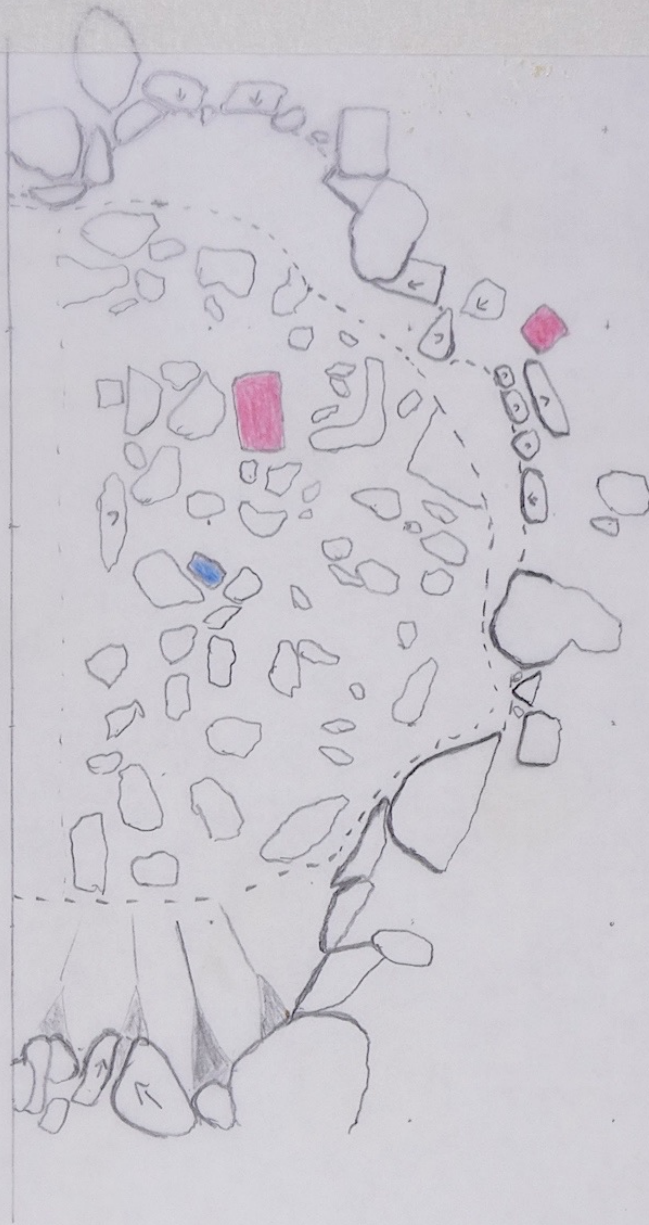

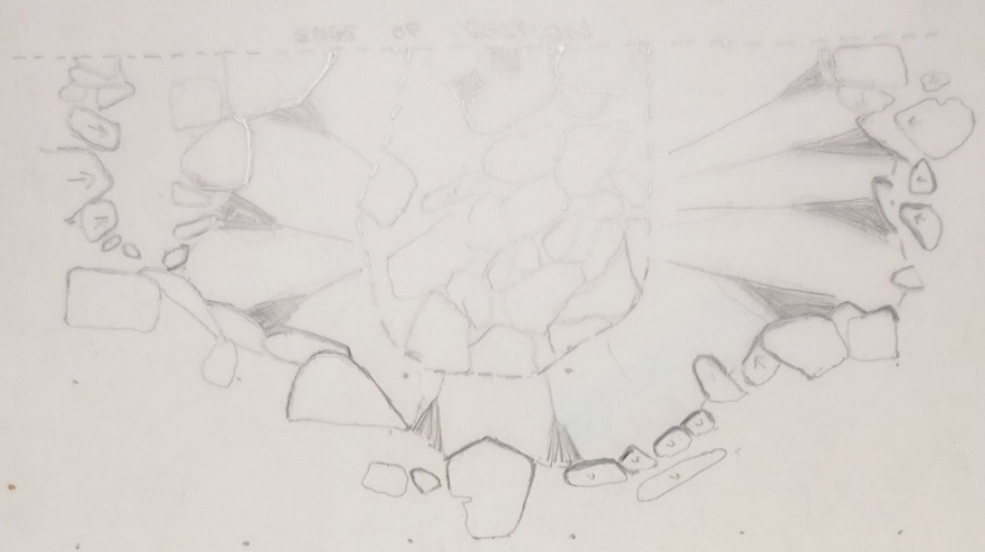

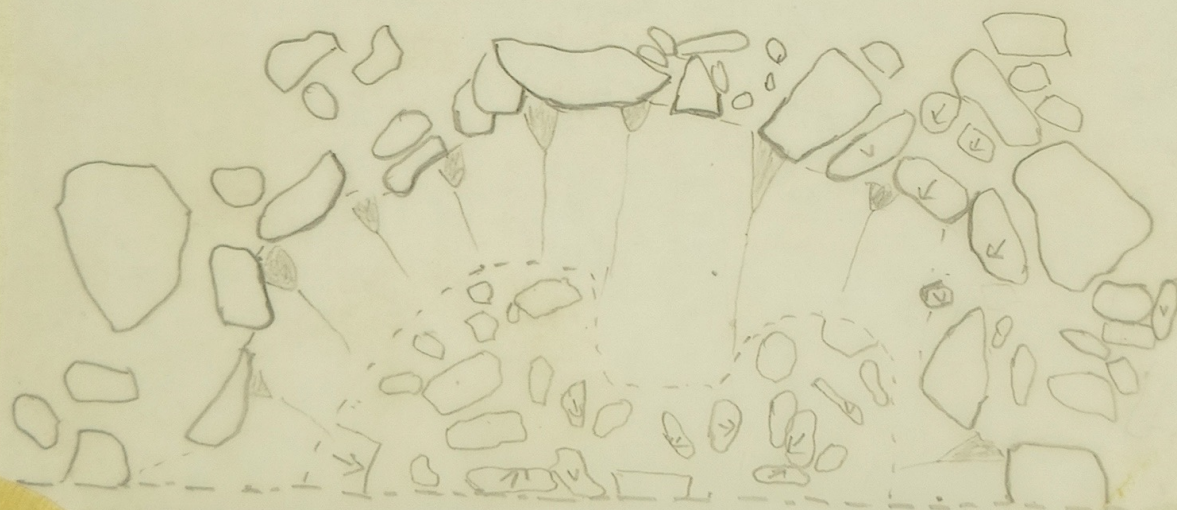

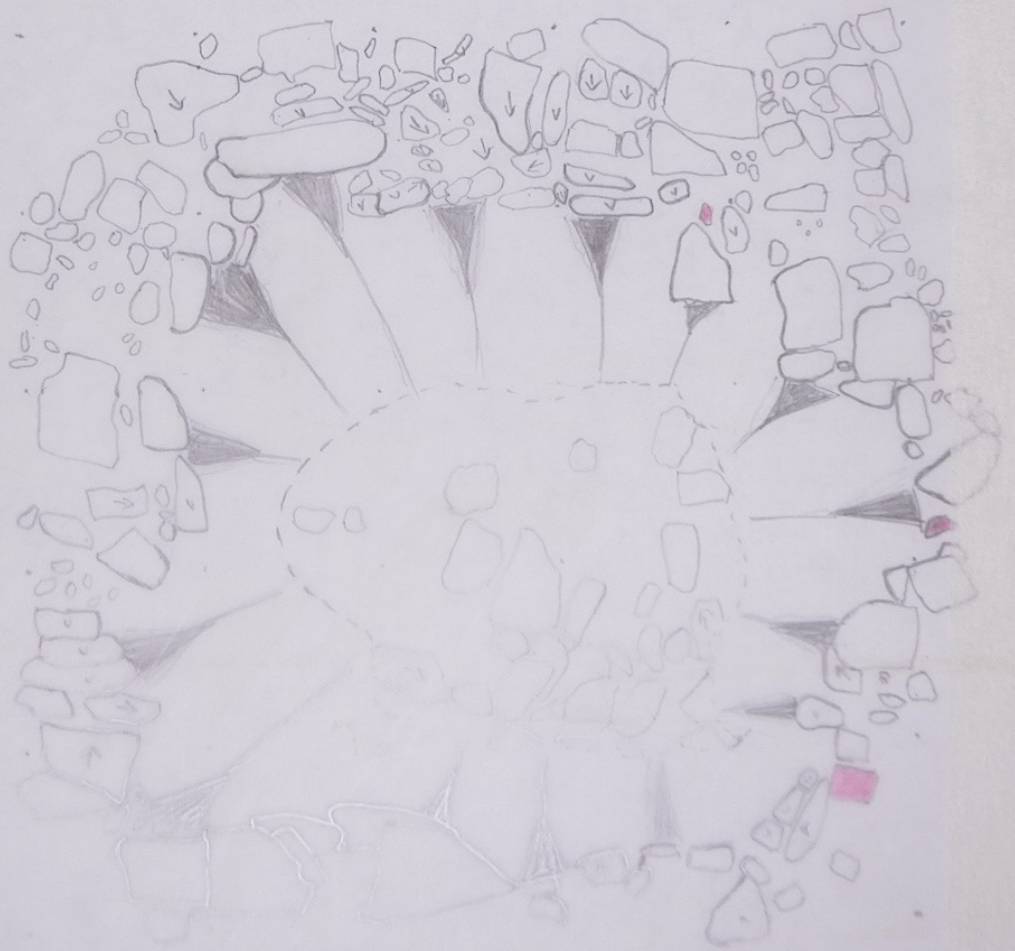

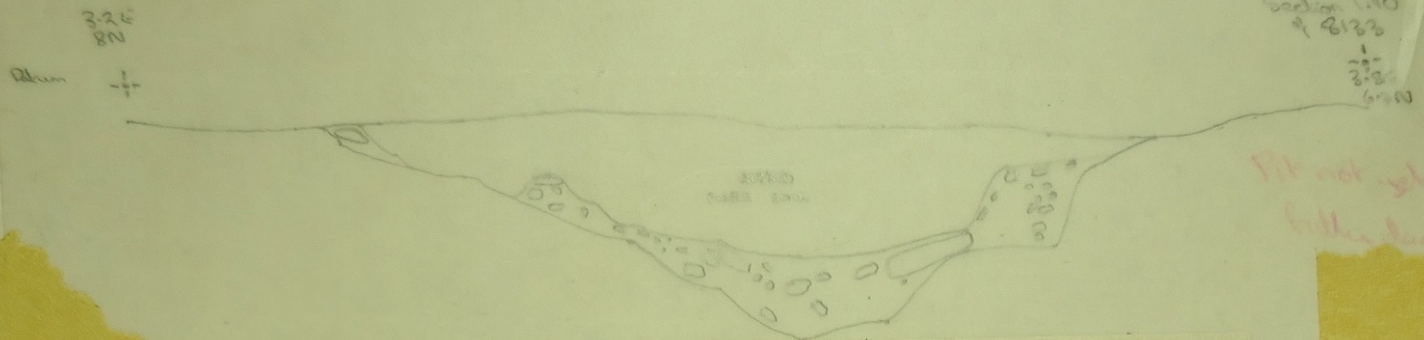
FEATURE PLAN ⑥ of f8133

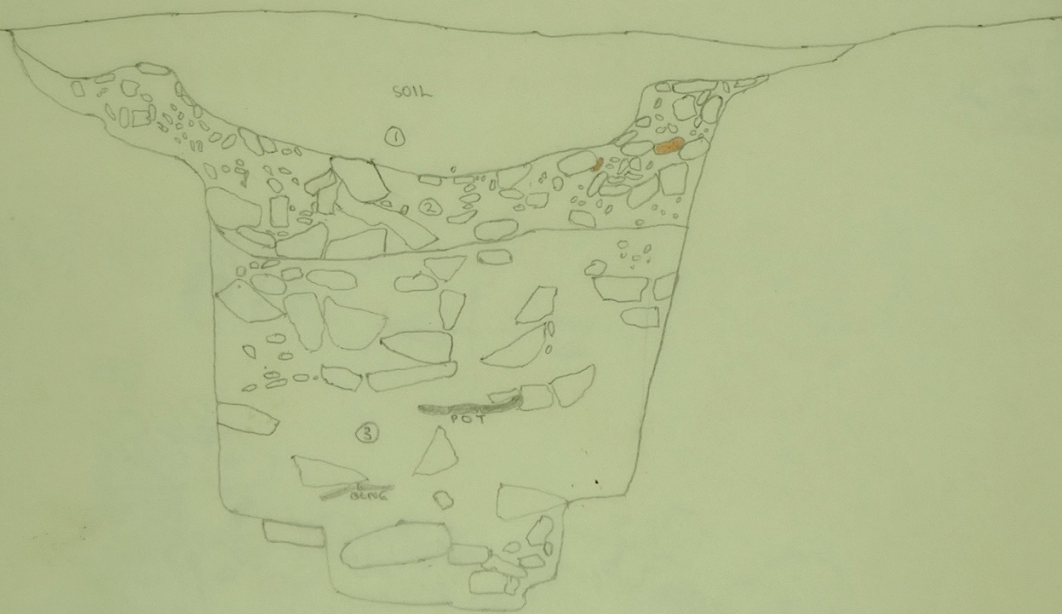

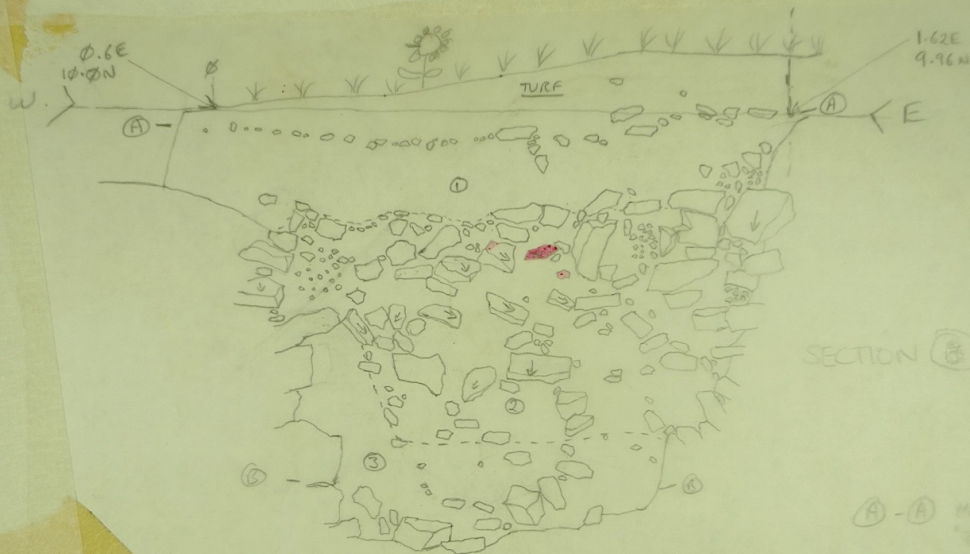

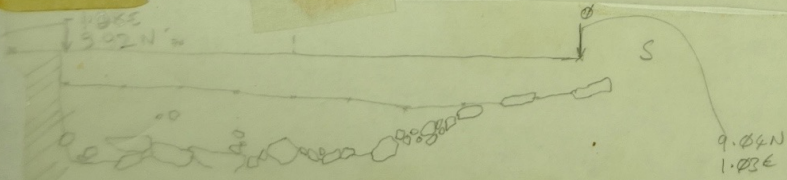

SECTION (B)

- ① - ② Marker line of "old" spoil heap remains
- ① Dark brown soil, few small stones
- ② Large stones, many tipping, with dark greyish soil infill
- ③ Light brown sticky material with fewer stones.
- ④ - ⑥ Marks approx line of small burnt gravel debris, charcoal & bone, not visible in section.
