It was then sectioned NE-SW, across by a possible associated ~~stone~~ area of stone (? idf. of hole); what was removed appeared to be large stones (possibly bedrock) except in the S. part.

Finally, 2 lg. joints appeared below, and it was concluded that the feature was due to purely natural causes
