No chipples at bottom. It would appear that there was originally a large post hole - this was packed (As shown in section) possibly after hut was demolished - the small post hole was cut probably somewhat later for it appears that the old one was not visible or they would have cut it in the centre - but on the other hand a post hole was necessary for the circular structure - perhaps the post hole was cut into the side deliberately and the large post hole packed. I think the later argument more likely.
