DESCRIPTION Post hole (hut circle) Post hole - one of hut circle - not visible on surface - arc taken from centre at 5m 80 - distance measured from F482 116cm. Fill of small stones chipples and brown earth layer ① - no packing stones, particularly loose fill - unlike some others in structure e.g. F490 - goes down into a stone free brown

↓ layer ② - the soil being apparently the same as ①, the lack of stones being the only difference. This in turn changes into a stone free grey layer of similar consistency to layer ② in F481 (though no stones) - 2-3cm above the bedrock was a sticky grey/yellow layer (primary silt ④).

PLACING No signs of burning in fill (no red stones) - apart from a few fragments of daub on the surface around the post hole, there were no finds.
