when cleaned up the bedrock showed that it had been cut on either side of the joint (see diagram) thus giving the very bottom of the posthole. The sides are too difficult to distinguish except perhaps the southern side because the whole area is very disturbed. Similarly the infill was difficult to distinguish between proper post hole infill and geologically disturbed areas, but it mainly consisted of flat stone lying irregularly with very little soil in between.
