ASSOCIATED FEATURES connected with F 529, F530, F531, F532, F533 and F534 making a circular structure (roundhouse)

ASSOCIATED FINDS Charcoal/grey earth, Pieces of daub mixed with subsoil and occasionally pieces of pink oblitic stone (burnt)

↓ DESCRIPTION CONTINUED

as there is a joint line running East-West at the bottom of the posthole.

At about 40cm down pieces of charcoal and grey earth soil came out of which most has been kept for a soil sample possible C14.

~~MASONRY~~ The bottom of the charcoal was at about 60cms, 5cm short of the bottom of the posthole. Below this the grey layer continued, but no flat stones were resting on the base. Pieces of daub mixed with sub-soil plus grey

layer and the very occasional pink oolitic stone (burnt)
