



629 ? Early soil thickness: brown; associated with 628, 605, & ~~overlying~~ 601.

630 ? PH-like feature N. of 605. Burnt stones, brown soil fill.

617=631 Patisade trench/ditch: Swards continuation of 617.

632 P.H. associated with 631.

633 Small cluster of burnt stones over 601, prob- associated with 629/605/606 complex.

634 Area immediately N. of major tree-hole in CIVA & N. bank.  
[NB: this area now includes all flat area in N. half of CIVA.]

635 Flat tract E. of 612 is S. half of former CIVA

636 P.H. on edge of 622

637 Group of stones, some burnt, immediately S. of tree hole in CIVA. Overties F.699 ① & F.634 ⑤.

638 Concentration of charcoal + burnt stones on floor of 603.  
Fallen timber?

639 Burnt stone in ? PH. over 601.

640 Cluster of burnt stones over 601

641 Furrow in 601: badgers?

642 Patch of burnt stones in 604 ②, E. of 617.
