with chipples layer 3, with larger stones and brown soil on top layer ①. F957 appears to have layers.
layer ① brown soil and stones looking like disturbed bedrock as in F491.
layer ② "red"/brown soil sticky - not more than 5cm thick -
soil sample taken though certainly slightly contaminated by layer ③ Only contains small stones?
layer ③ yellow/white "chalky" substance found with chipples (as in gull in BXII (1)) - probably entirely natural - possibly just where gull runs through. Gull has layer ② of F957 but instead of going into
P.T.O.

into ③ (of F957) has yellow chipple layer.
