~~COMMENT~~ all angles. The stones were poorly compacted, and their looseness had facilitated considerable root / rootlet penetration. The lack of consolidation might indicate a relatively recent age for the bank and hollow, possibly a small quarry-hole for the stone wall immediately to the north of S. 99. However the hollow seems to be in line with the outer Neolithic ditch-line of 1971-2 seasons.

Its top surviving layer 1168 ② was one of sharp, angular stone rubble varying in size from large slabs to small stones. [See 599 Plan 2]. No structure or pattern could be discerned in the layout of these stones. F. 1168 ② had as a "basal" layer an apparently laid stone surface, of medium sized and large slabs. However, this stone slab "surface" was present only in one small area, and cannot be considered as a structural feature.
