

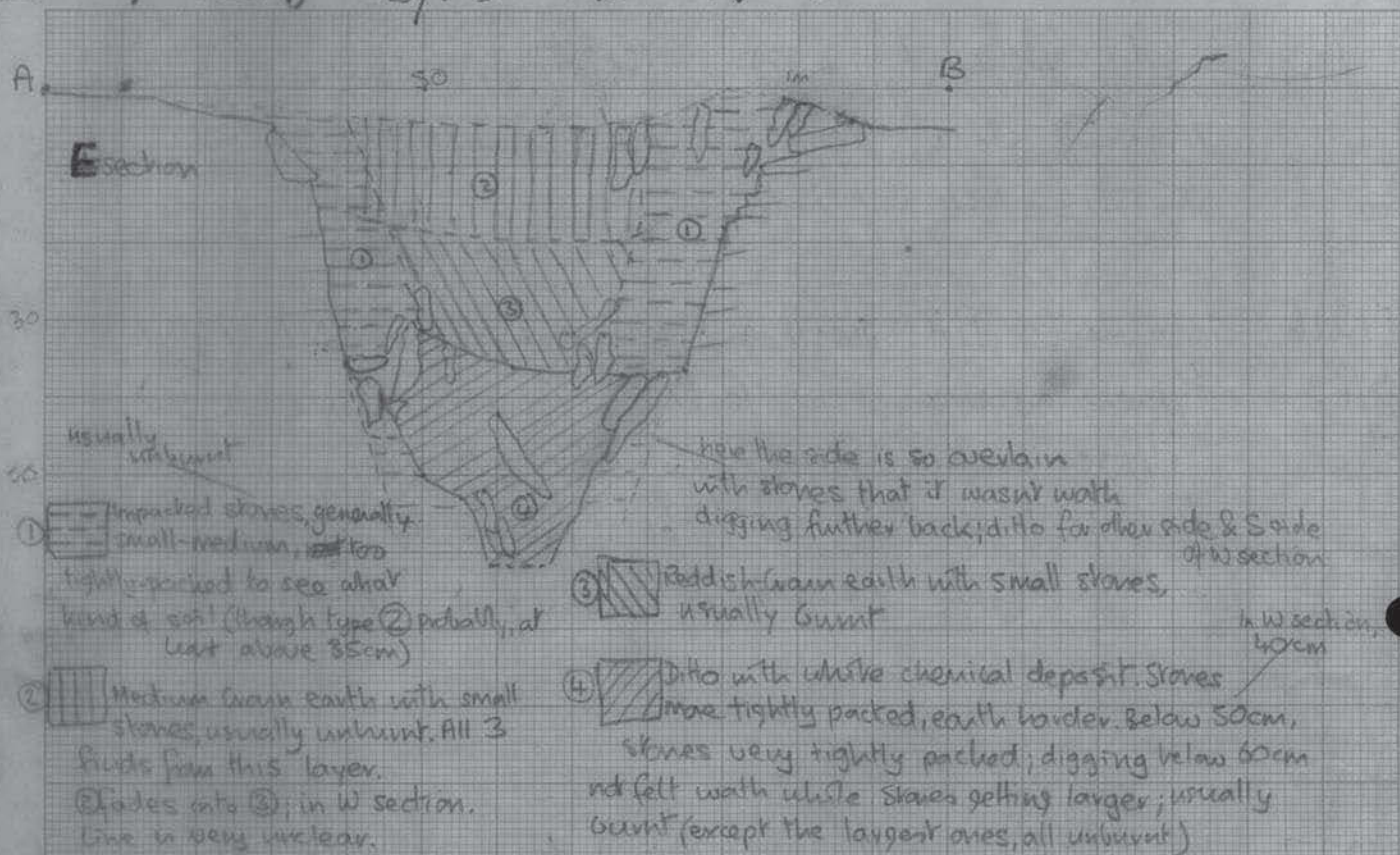
August 7th. After another night of heavy rain all P.H.s filled with water again. Sunshine at 9 am. helped drying process

F1218. Continued. 1 metre wide section of ^{earthy} pebbly feature which runs WNW / ESE through both sections B/G3 + B/F3. Area selected in B/F3 with approx centre NW 10.30 NE 5.50. At a depth of 35-40 cms the sides slope slightly towards the centre. No finds, but large quantities of burnt material (See F1219). Consider this may be a natural fissure.

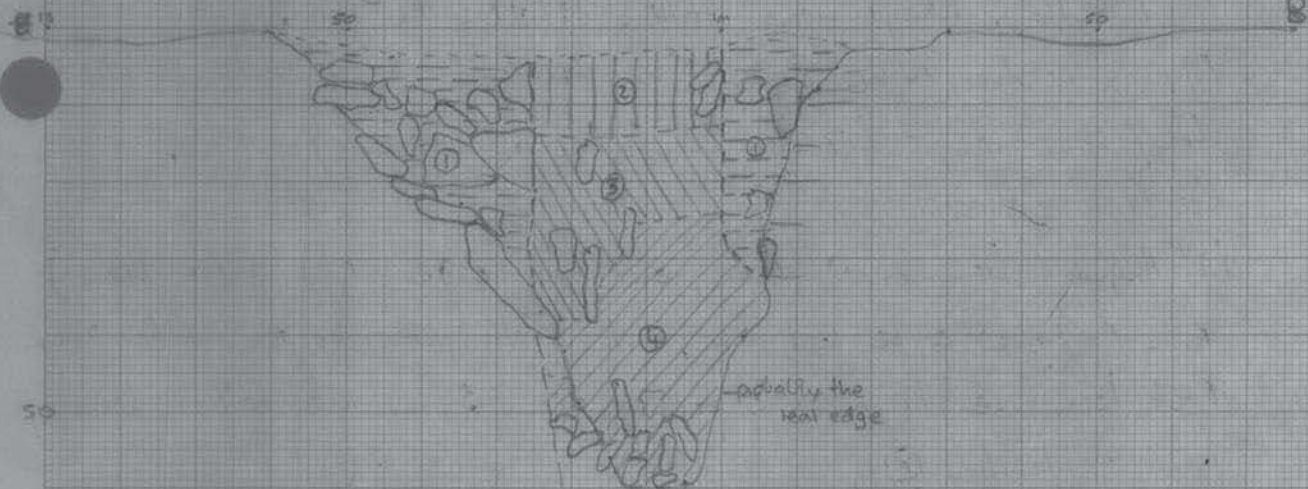

SONDAGE
At level (i) an indeterminate circular area on the edge of the long earth/pebble feature mentioned in F1218. Within a half metre circle many finds of bone, pot and daub. Consider this is a PH cut into fissure on one side and rock on the other. Approx centre N.W. 8.70 N.E. 5.10. Further examination seems to indicate that this is one side of the feature 1218, which may be a continuous long gutter, largely natural, possibly improved.

Aug 14th
Further area of this feature taken out to try to establish S. edge. No clear shape, but further small quantity of bone, 2 sherds pot discovered.
