F1233 Stakehole, round, 20cm across, 27cm deep.

B/F3 Approx centre: NE SE

Not sectioned; shape at level ① typical. No finds.

F1234 Round shallow hole with upstanding triangle from tangents

B/F2-3 1/2 way up. No finds. Approx centre: on cutting edge, 6.50 from W

Sectioned. Nail A (B/F2) SW 6.12 NW 11.65

Nail B: on cutting edge exactly, 6.80 from W

F1235 Rough potato size P. H. ^{46/50} 31 x 17 cm, 20cm deep. ~~Not~~ Almost

B/F3 entirely filled with large vertical stones. What one makes of this I don't know. Not sectioned.

Approx centre: NW 7.60, NE 3.70

F1236

Nasty rectangular hole, ^{almost certainly} ~~probably~~ manmade. Stones and earth; chipples at bottom. ^{NS} 33 x 27 cm; 17cm deep. Not sectioned.

B/F2


Approx centre: SW 2.35 NW 10.08

F.1237 A badly formed approx circular hole. See section drawing.

B/G3 Only the SE side appeared to be bed-rock. Half sectioned drawn & taken out. This feature lies in a triangular area of very disturbed stone in the NW corner of B/G3.


Centre of F1237 NW 2.27 SW. 8.40 diam 34cm depth 35cm below ①


