Fine, hot, dry. Continued investigating possible small features in both cuttings

Extreme NW corner B/E3 1/2 metre from post, very disturbed area produced 2 sherds pot.

B/E3

Investigated possibility of further P.H. to match with F1219 and F1225 at Eastern end of fissure F1218. First Kosselling produced bone and sherds of pot. Appears to be possible P.H. Half sectioned Triangulations from B/F3 posts SE + SW. Large number of finds including several definitive sherds of pot, much bone, pebbles claut and 1 frag flint. Surprisingly, N side of PH has well cut wall, which naturally merges into indefinite E + W sides as hole cuts into fissure. Bottom at 57 cms below surrounding bed rock.

Taken out after drawing. Large sherds of pot, 33 cms from level A-B. Further v. large sherds (40 cms ^{depth}) on SW. side, together with much bone. As presumed, only N side can be considered to have a definite side.

Small shallow almost circular P.H. No burning, no finds. Approx centre NE 1.30, SE 8.95. Av diam 20 cms. Depth from 15-20 cms below (1).
