F2101 THE CAUSEWAY.

DITCH 853 is interrupted on the cutting by a causeway, not previously plotted. A cutting extension is planned to locate where 853 begins again. The extension northwards takes in about 8sq. m., taking in the bank between CIV and CI. An extension has also been cut westwards to take in most of the bank area between CIV and CII. It is hoped that both these new areas will give more details about the causeway.

At edge of ditch there is small area, sloping greatly from hard edge of gull down to ditch edge natural. This is filled with loosely packed, large lost blocks in a soft brown earth. Some of these were so large and arranged in such a way that their deliberate placing seems certain though not in the form of a wall. (F2104)

It appears (30.7.75) now that the ditch may continue, though in a different form, across the area previously thought to be a causeway. The ditch continuation has been given a new number, 2105.

Layer ① Loosely packed lost blocks in loose ^{dark} brown soil.

Layer ② Light brn, compact soil, much burning, some large stones.

Layer ③ Soft grey/brown sandy material directly above hard yellow material running below wall.

Layer ④ Hard yellow natural.
