DESCRIPTION *Possible post/stake hole. Indicated by packing stones in surface of F 3407 after removal of site layers ②. Shallow with indistinct-irregular sides, does not cut bedrock but has relatively flat base. Fill of loose brown dirt with clogged stones.*

This is the most likely post/stake hole of a number of possible small features cutting F 3407. The jumbled nature of the limestone rocks forming the fill of F 3407 make it impossible to be certain that the angled shores of F 3408, 3409 & 3410 are indeed packing stones or to be sure of their sides.
