ASSOCIATED FINDS

COMMENT *This layer contains many pitched stones of medium size, in ~~the~~ a generally small-stone matrix. Much of this layer had a worn - and in places 'crushed' appearance, as if formerly a walking surface. To the NE this layer continues down the rock-cut slope of 3474 (the large hollow), apparently post-dating the latter. However, this stony layer may comprise more than one phase of stone surface, and indeed may not be the same layer laterally.*

PHASING

The fill on 3475. This peters out around N.4.0. E.4.0.
