ASSOCIATED FINDS **2 sherds of a thin black ware of BB appearance.**

COMMENT **Is this a hollow for a structure? e.g. floor of circular hut?**
Does 3475 extend southwards to cut part of this hollow (3476) ? - Because it seems to.

The stones of 3475 peter out southwards over this hollow, and constitute a very thin layer, with sheets of bedrock exposed in patches. Some small burnt stones
