AND DISCREET. IT IS MAINLY BLUE, WITH SOME RED. - POSSIBLE FIRE AREA.
BEING SURROUNDED BY STONES WITH THE APPEARANCE OF HAVING
BEEN TIPPED INTO THE HOLLOW.
