COMMENT This appears on Plan 2 as a soil/small stone patch is visible at that stage of excavation and is possibly cut through 3481? - probably.

Layer 1. medium pitched stones with dark brown soil, with close-packed small stones.

Layer 2. small stones with much red-brown soil. lower packing stones large & vertical/pitched layers separated by hard-packed horizontal stones.
