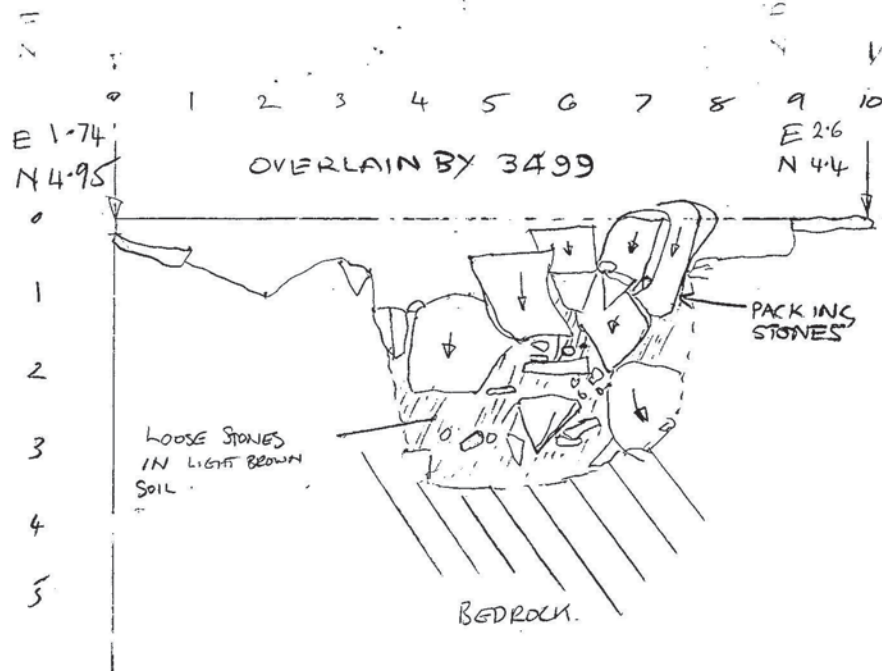

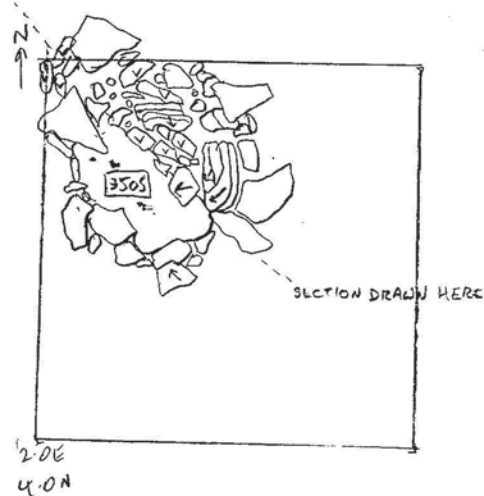
COMMENT The fact that 3499 makes this p.h. is not helpful. 3499 has been severely root-disturbed, and there is a strong possibility that this p.h. was cut through it, if not also through 3475 which lay above 3499. This p.h. matches three others: 3492, 3593, 3501, and the four would seem to form a rectangular structure
