COMMENT ~~This~~ This was first noticed as small circular area of dark soil showing in ~~the~~ 2961 - which here is at c. 5cms below original surface. As it was excavated ~~the~~ burnt limestone occurred, + the finds. The excavated hole - measured above - is the final shape of the post-hole, cut into the gull, the small circular area presumably being post-pipe.

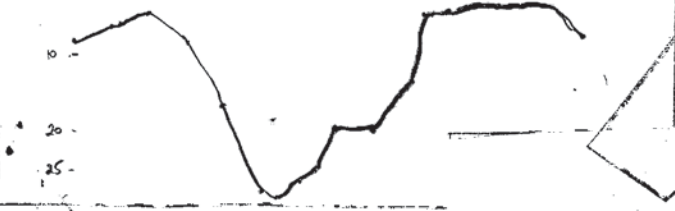
