In most areas in the ditch the chipples were mixed with quite a lot of earth - possibly because there were such a lot of roots in the ditch.

ASSOCIATED FINDS pot., bone, flint -
Pills on a pot, especially from the southern section of the cutting.
Very small flecks of charcoal occurred in 4602 (2) just south of the housewife bank - see sketch plan.

COMMENT Fill of 4602: 4606 = layer (2) of 4602.

In section 4602 (1) + (2) were very difficult to distinguish -
are probably the same layer - with (1) being slightly more disturbed - the chips mixed with topsoil.

only partly overlay 4602 (4) + was a very thin pho.

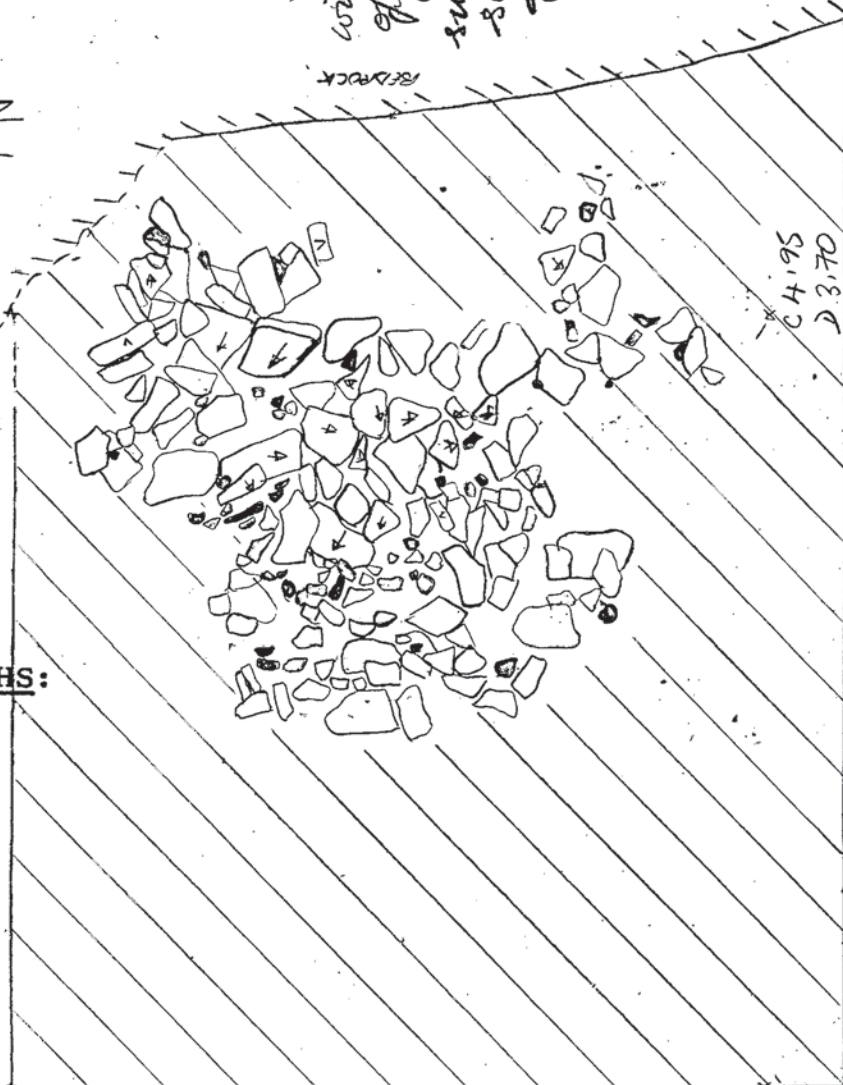

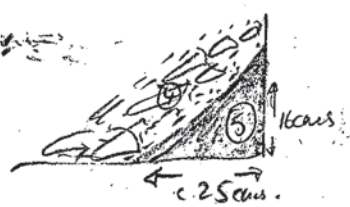
