COMMENT This area was very much disturbed by roots - particularly those of the tree growing almost on the edge of the ditch. - Most of the slabs seemed to be lying over

the chippie - (4602 ①), but there was a great deal of topsoil mixed in with them, and in fact the bedrock along the edge seemed to have been broken up by PHASING roots, which seem to run along the bedding planes + separate slabs of bedrock.
