Pot, burnt clay, bone, bronze ring, May Hill
Qnt, flintCOMMENT When taking soil samples of the black
soil between the stones of 4615 it was found
that the black soil had become rather mixed with
the top of the chippie — However 4616
seemed to be distinguished by its far greater
PHASING no. of finds — so one made clear which finds
came from the top of 4616 by marking them 0-1 cms.
4616 1-2 cms still has some black soil mixed with the chippie,
but less than 0-1 cms.
2-3 cms was virtually all chippie - v. little black soil
