COMMENT This feature did not seem promising after brushing down to F4758 and the removal of the top (ie worn layer) of F4758. Only after the area was trowelled down to bedrock did the feature warrant investigation - at this point the feature appeared as a patch of sloping loose small to medium stones with some burning. The fill contained these stones and soil with small burnt stones all the way down. The feature was not $\frac{1}{2}$ sectioned as initially the feature was too small. The feature is a small peep hole.
