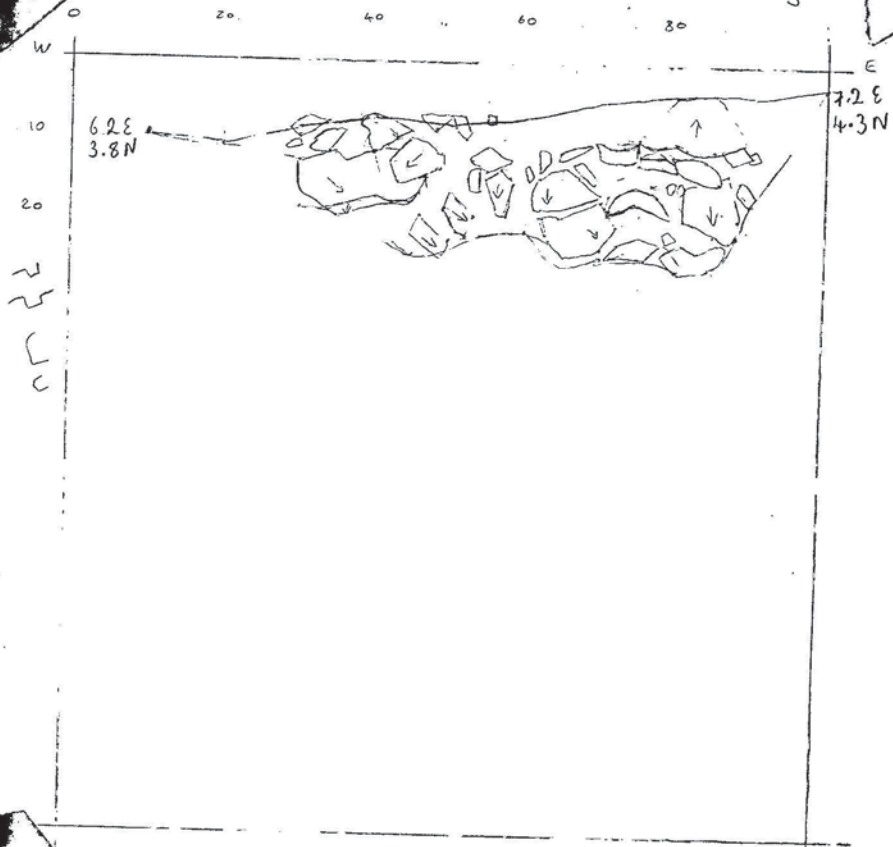
ASSOCIATED FINDS

COMMENT Excavated air lift by box sections which revealed medium and large jumbled stones after removal of top layer of small material. Later decided to excavate the rest of the apparent feature in plan to locate any edges.

12-8-89. Taking a layer of stones off in plan did not reveal any edges - only a layer of jumbled stones without clear edges - abandoned the feature. PHASING as not a real feature - After the area was traversed down to bedrock - a ~~fault~~ narrow fault line of vertical stones was revealed running ~~under~~ in the line of the apparent feature.
