COMMENT Excavated $\frac{1}{2}$ in $\frac{1}{2}$ section. Removal of verteals did not reveal an edge. Far down into the feature large flat stones fitted well into the feature. The bottom was not flat. Conclusion that the hole was a natural hollow - filled in naturally - not a man-made feature
