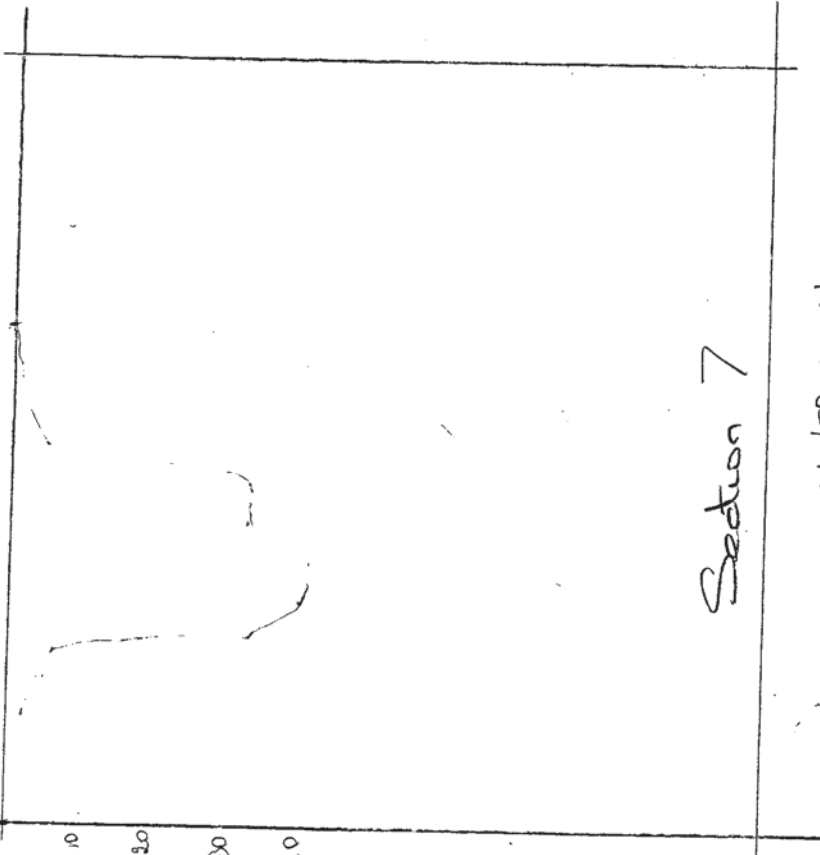
COMMENT Ravaled after area trampled down to bedrock.
