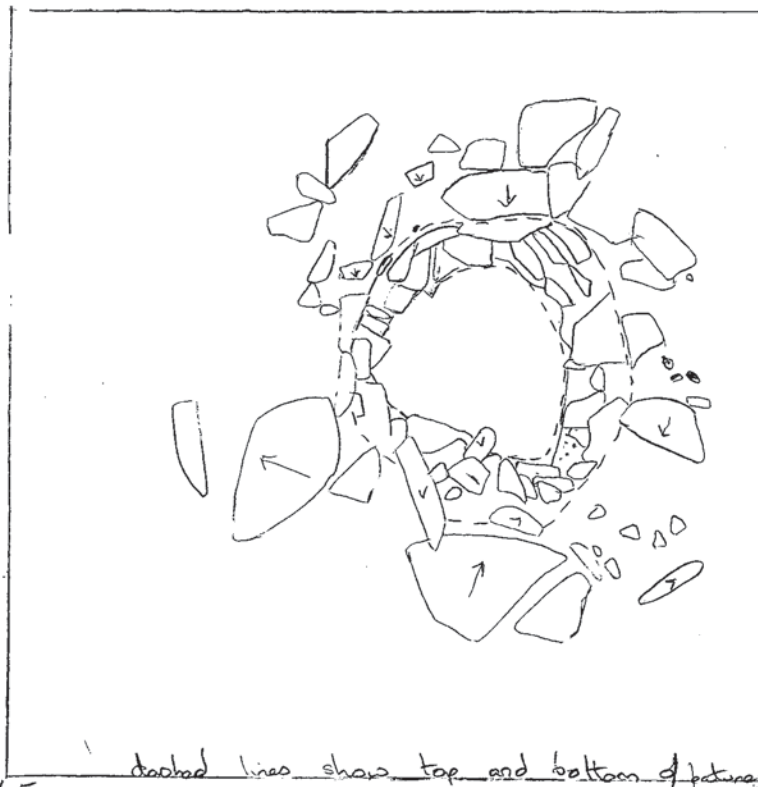
ASSOCIATED FINDS

Revealed after initial travelling of 4759
COMMENT Excavated in 1/2 section - S side - but the whole feature appeared on this side - the N side travelled down to bedrock.

The fill was largely composed of blue and red small loose stones and dark soil. The walls of the post hole were not particularly firm - but the stones were all horizontal - the tips of the pointed ones (well down in the feature) were red. Small post hole

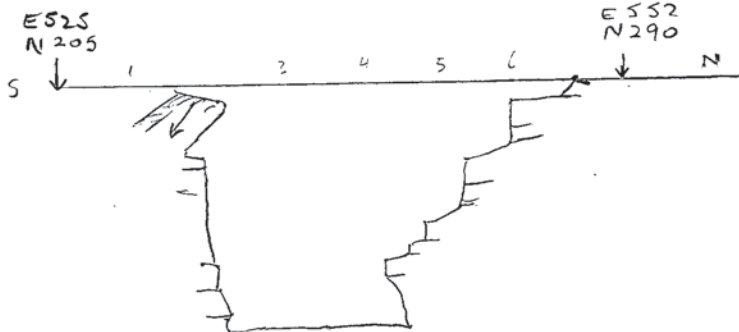
