COMMENT was sectioned as if intrusive but proved not to be  
— No: it is intrusive: see Section 10. It is sealed by 6832 which in turn is overlain by 6865 (collapsed 1d entrance wall?) ∴ it must be 1d or even 1b, and not 4 as alternatively thought
