COMMENT

Effective rain showed this 'layer' to be an intrusive trenchfill, cutting F. TH 1 (1) & (2). No post holes were discernable within it; and its southern (N-S) stretch may have held a sleeper beam or threshold beam - the latter perhaps for the entrance to the DK. Age path through the I.A. rampart.

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
