ASSOCIATED FINDS

COMMENT *Excavation began on 24.7.88 with removal of top 9 cm., revealing a near-horizontal platform built in centre of cutting at 4m 1.5 E. The platform is resting on top of 8603, and thus should be equated with 8618 (backwall, period 3) ∴ the burnt stones of 8603 had merely been spread back over the platform 8604 by foot erosion i.e. reverse stratigraphy*
