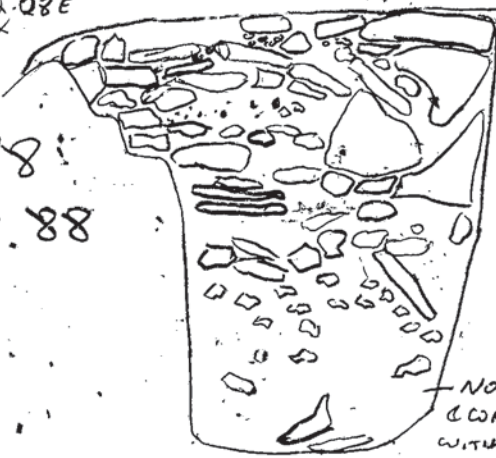
COMMENT *Not a feature, but a rodent hole: modern*

12.8.88: wrong: this is a rodent hole taking advantage of a pre-existing post hole, the S-edge of which is the cut bedrock edge 8651. This p.h. is in fact 8629, recognised at a high level during excavation of 8631 (see S.2). For fill, see section overlay. This p.h. may well match 8656 to the S, and both look as though they are part of the main line of front p.h.'s just behind the outer wall of the ramparts.

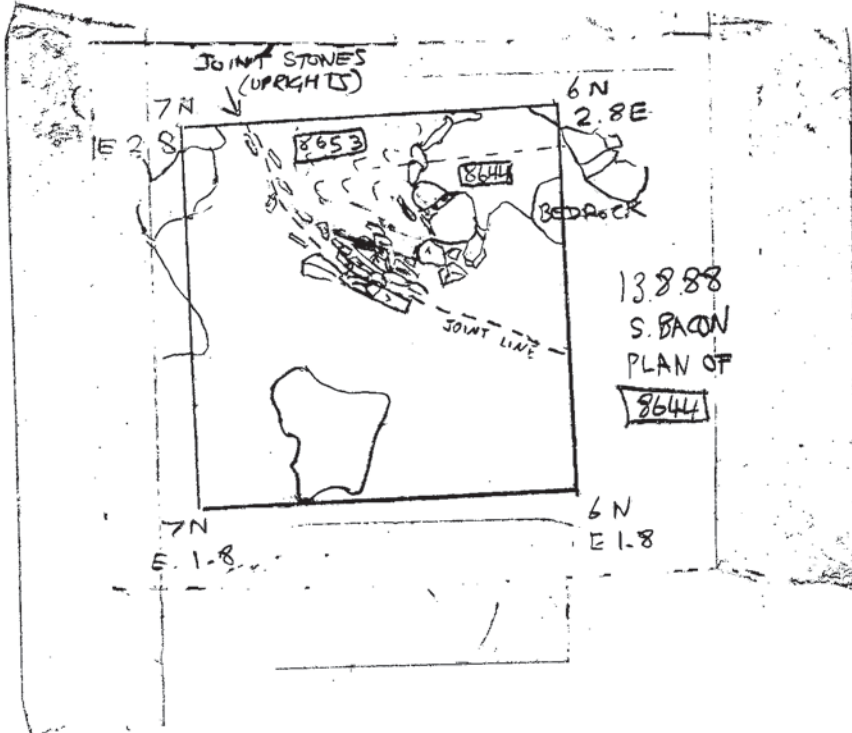
