DESCRIPTION long narrow band of 1000 v small burnt stones and many v small to medium stones. On ex shown to be port hole with two layers ① dark brown soil, and ② reddish brown soil with many small - small stones with 1000 burning. Layer ① probably wash between two into a depression between two possible areas of bedrock. Layer ② is fill.

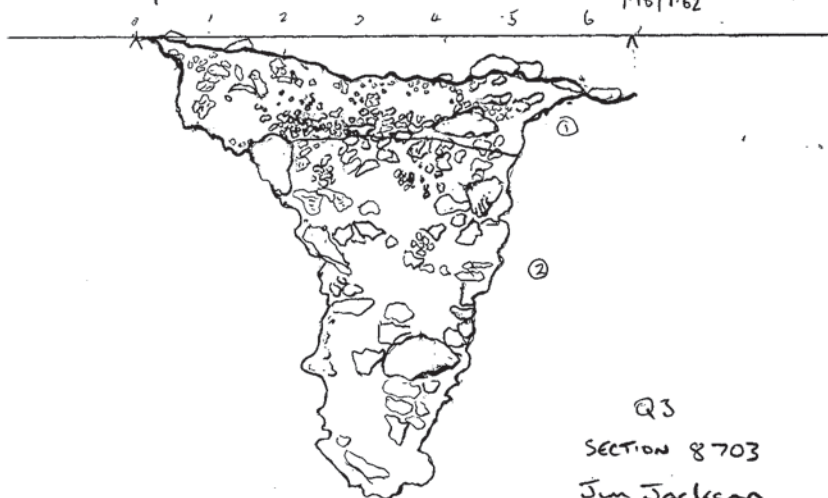

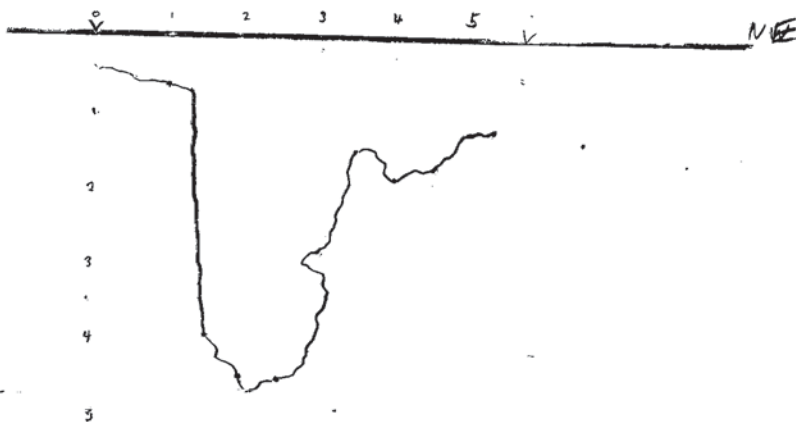
