COMMENT A shallow pit cut down into senigull bedrock. The edge of the pit is vague in parts particularly to the north and east. The fill covers one posthole and is cut by another.

At time of excavation no obvious function and no obvious association with anything else could be found for this pit.

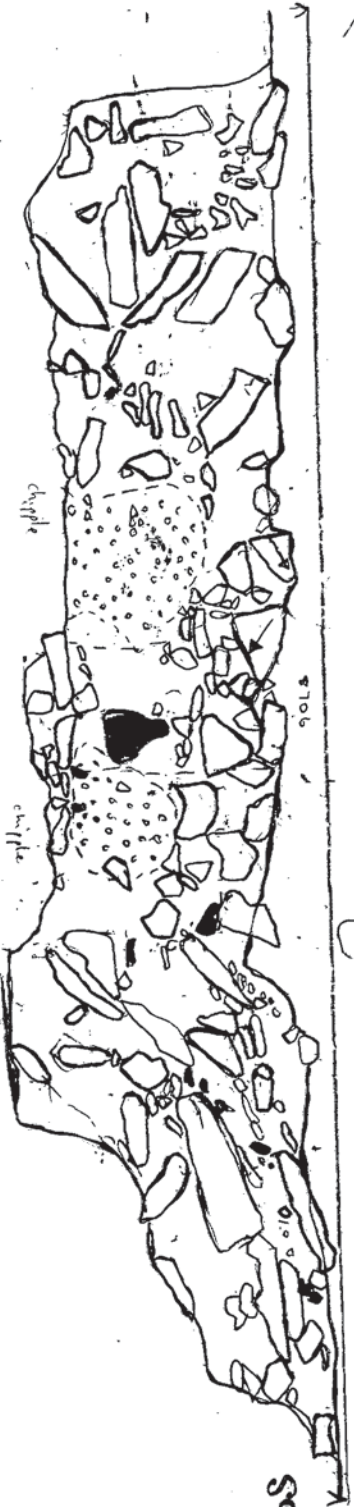

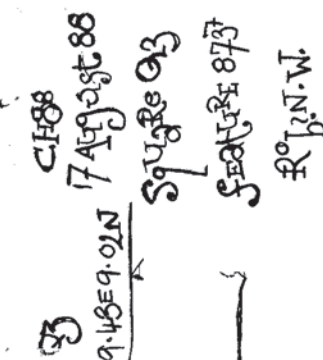
