A bank of brown soil with few medium & small stones. On crossing the soil more stones appeared & they have a distinctly worn appearance - (15 lies in a slight depression between 9507 & 9508) a stone coin noted. At the slightly rocky appearance of soil the soil on bank underlying... P10

Comments

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9514 derives from work from 9560. However this thin slice of reddish brown soil disappeared on a light clean (i.e. up to 1 cm removed revealing a brown soil, was NOT given a separate number

The area of work is defined on Plan 4 W97 + See Plan 4A CH91

South of the North bench no sign of work appears - see Plan 4 ~~9514~~

9626 is in a distinct hollow between 9553 & 9505 but this is also an area of extensive rabbit & root disturbance. CH91 clearing shows work see Plan 4A CH91

9514 work area on Plan 4 should have been given a new number of 9514 Plan 1. This was not done due to misremembering what the Cag 9514 referred to - hence 9514 on Plan is much more extensive an area than the work on Plan 4. REN² in CH91.
