COMMENT This layer may be a dump of rubble for a bank reverted by wall 10002. This layer appears only to E. of the apparent dividing line 10018, but the burnt material in it nevertheless reflects that of 10007 above it, as is also the case in the area W. of 10018, where 10007 is PHASING reflected lower down by the burnt stone distribution in 10014.
