[J]- Shaped cut, visible in eastern side of Trench 1. Filled
 with weathered, medium stones, pitched towards the centre. Angled
 with [10088]. Not apparently visible in opposite side
 of trench 1, nor can it be seen in the western side of trench 2.
 This seems to suggest a differential depth along its length -
 if it should turn out to be continuous. Just north of JP2.
