## DESCRIPTION

Layer of small to medium stones in light brown sticky soil below rampart wall 10718. These are close packed and angular. They lie in the same strat. position as 10753 although they are "cleaner". Upon excavation this layer was found to be very shallow and the presumed N.W. equivalent 10753 cannot be equated with certainty.
