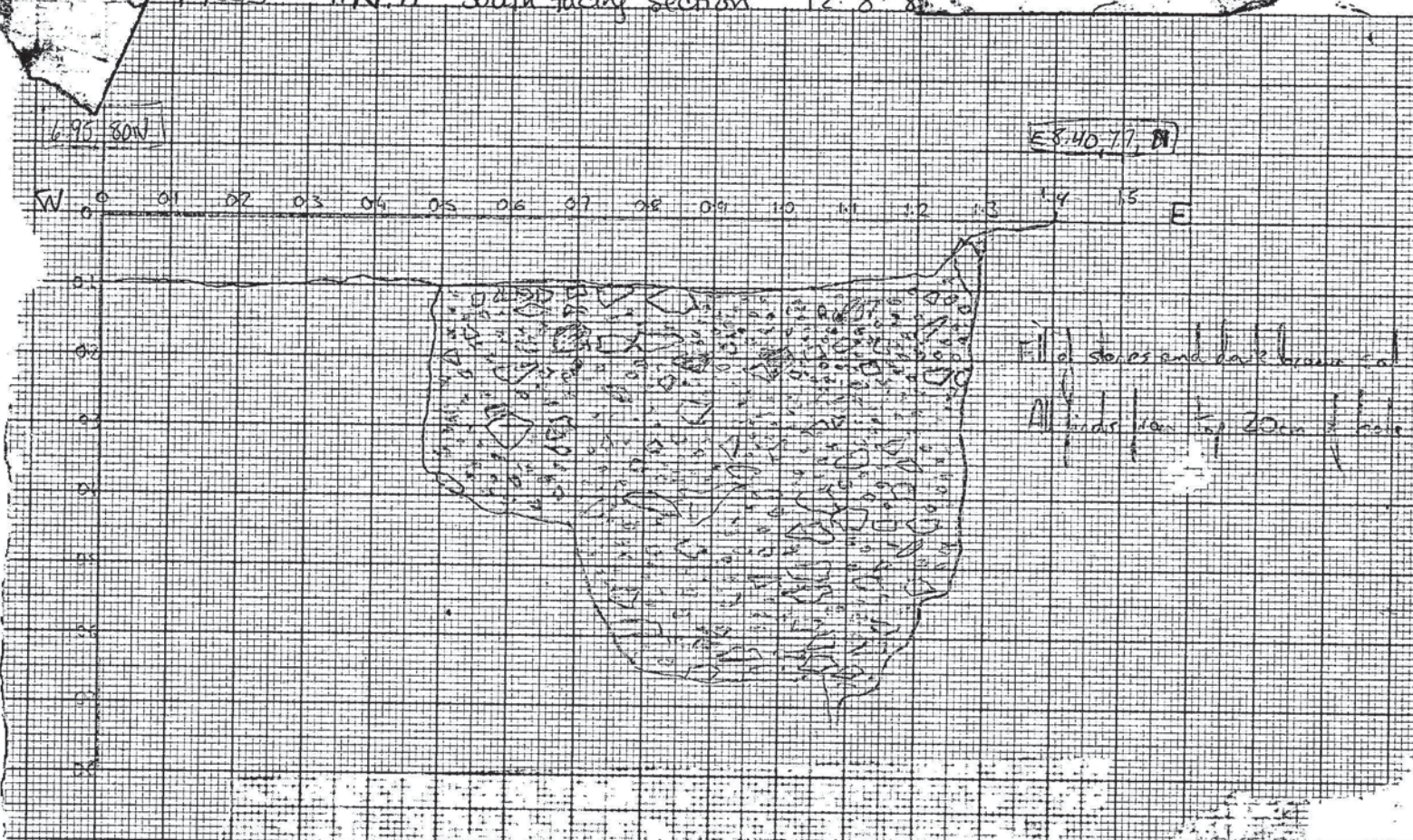
ASSOCIATED FINDS

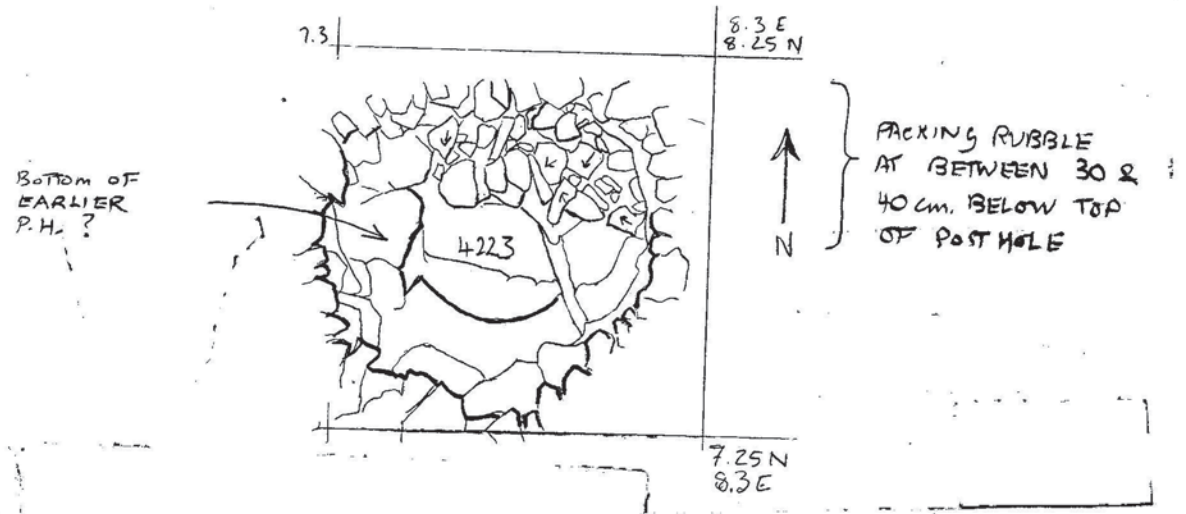
