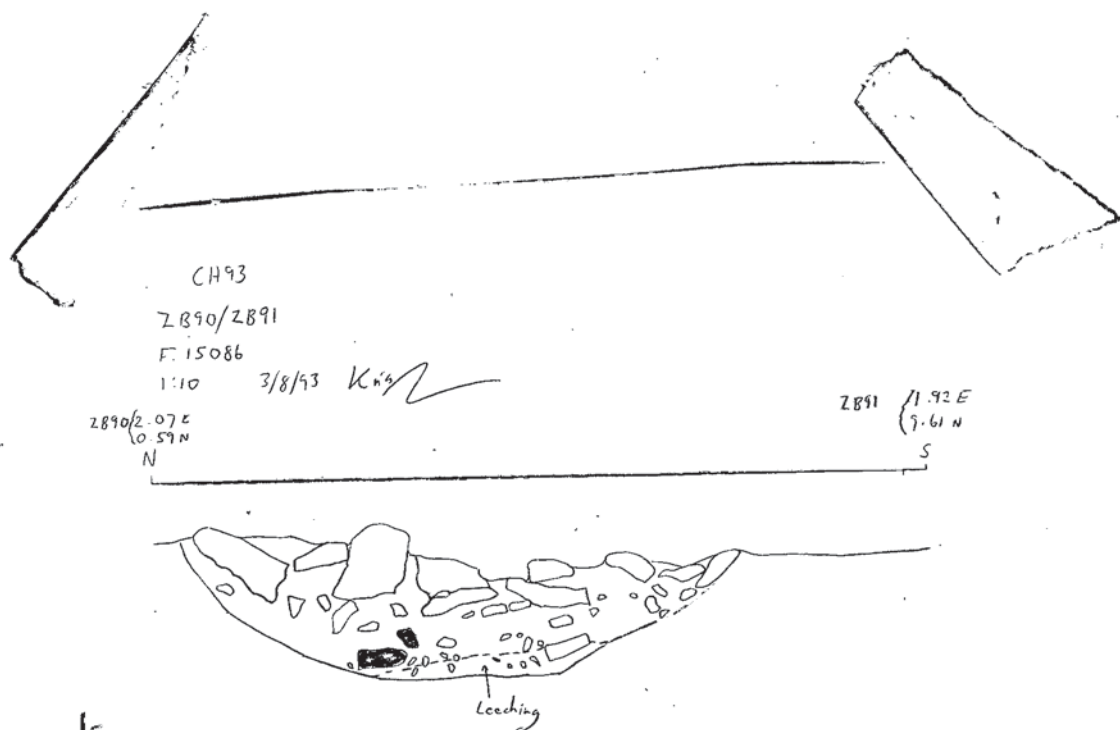

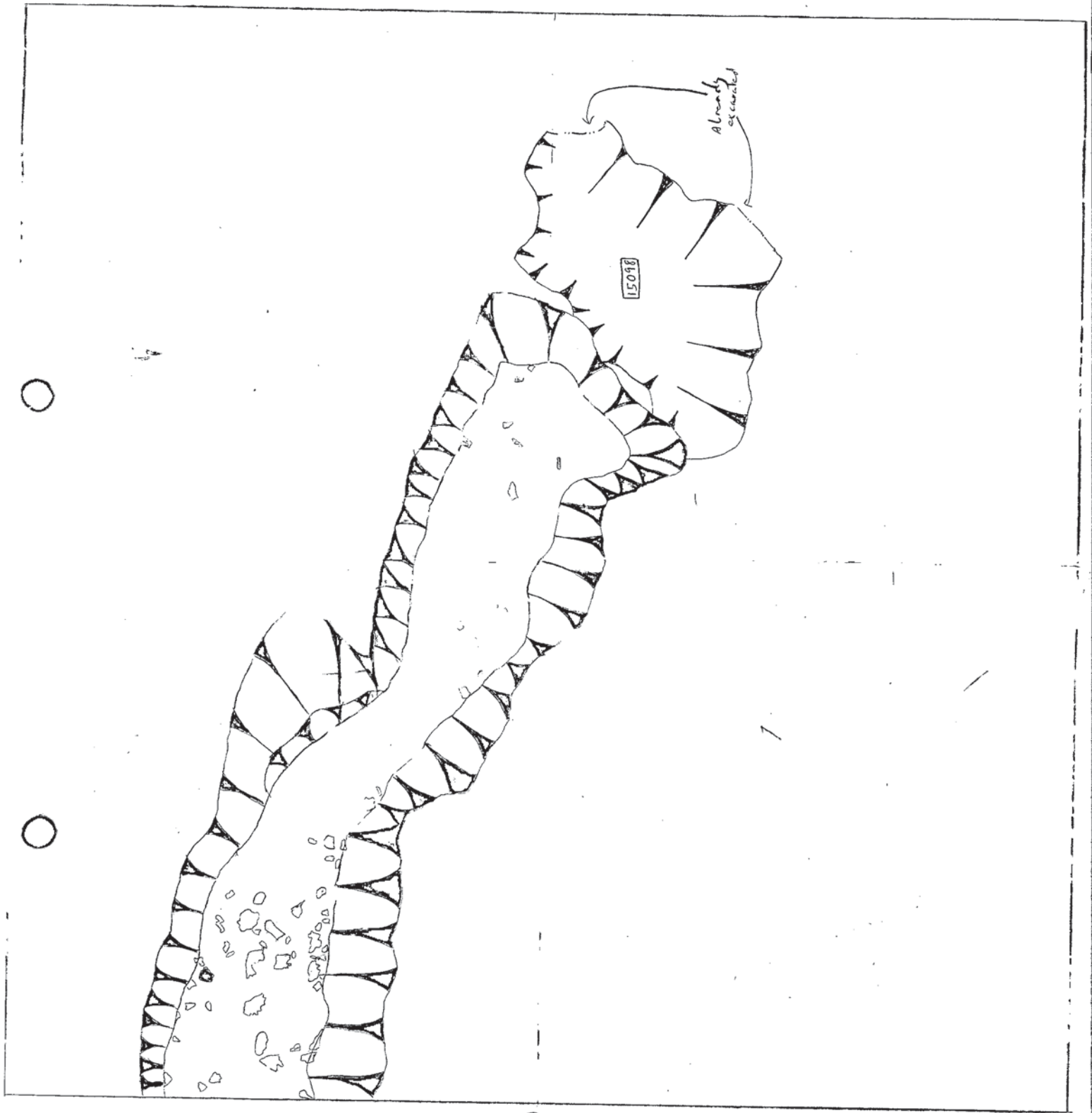
Ditch
