Red: yellow clay silt to the s. end of w. half of cutting. Small stone inclusions. Soil has naturally high clay % - similar to (15215) rather than (15214) matrix. First spit of 2: to remove this soil layer removed. Exposed large stones with high silt content as band across cutting. (15236)
