Grouped in situ pottery lying in a reddish brown soil with occ
scattered medium stone. No clear cut visible on horizontal around of 0.02m.
On sectioning appeared that there is no cut, rather a deliberate deposition
lying against upright/canted cemented semi gull on W. a rise in gull to the E.

The size of hole + pit indicates a deliberate placement of ² bricks/ recently broken
material. It is not a rubbish pit as there is far more stone placed here than "rubbish"
