

- ③ Soil as above in area defined by an approx circular line of medium stone - SAMPLED.
- ④ continuation of ③ the ground water very "ashy" layer across base of '571. Burnt stones set on this when other "1/2" of '571 removed layer. @ similar to 15571
- ⑤ included the stones present on section. The med. sized stones are angular in shape & some are rounded. Stones come from soil at edges. Stones in center. Stones form a "pyramid like" form.
