

COMMENT Area of large slabs in ~~S.W.~~ S.E. corner of pit - fewer finds - possibly represents earlier infill of pit. Main area of pit in W. and N. consists of black earth & smaller stones - many more finds - appears to overlay area of large slabs.

it is of a clayey rather than gravelly nature

(4) & (5) appeared to be contiguous, but after removing (5), a thin layer of (4) was found below.

* Therefore the numbering of (4) & (5) should be reversed, (see section drawing), although (4) & (5) were simultaneously exposed below (3) - see sketch on next page
