COMMENT Gull. On excavation of the bedrock rim of 3474 (at its NE corner) the solid laminated bedrock was found to change NE-wards into jumbled pink-matrix gull-type rock. The gull was not excavated lower than the level shown on the N. section of A6/89 (ie. the S-facing section of A6). PHASING
