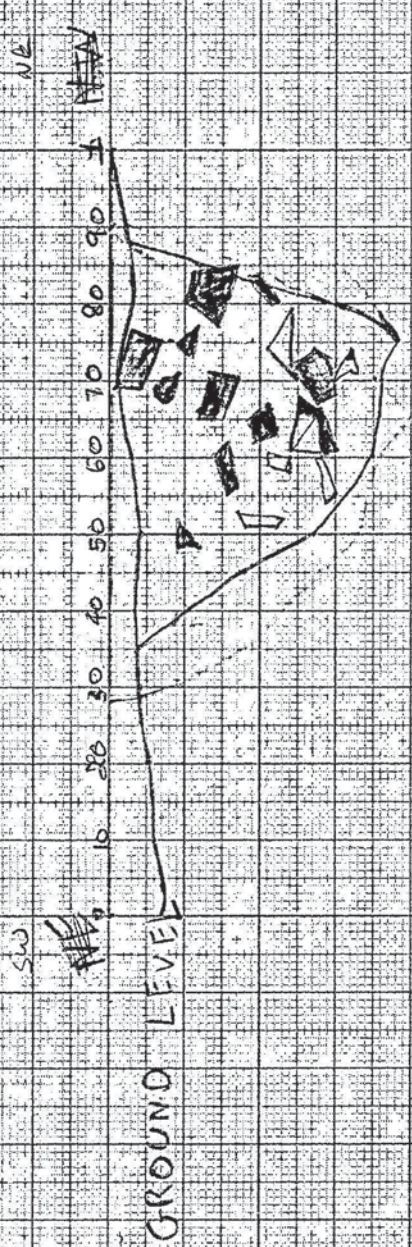
7/8/81 May be a natural fissure - burning continues along a line c 1m long. Seems to be a natural fissure but a very large amount of burning.
