

30.7.75 Commenced CVA. ↗

Removed turf over area 8m x 5m. immediately down slope from CV.

1.8.75 Trowelling top soil. Triangulated pegs for cutting. Labelled "AA" "BB" etc to avoid possible duplication. (Feature numbers to begin at 1926)

2.8.75. Trowelling to depth approx 10 cms. Greater depth of top soil and small stone than usual. Finds include much relatively modern material (Bottle glass, clay pipes, nails etc)

3.8.75. Commenced removal of layer 2 (in accordance with T. Courtney's section of F. 2020). P. Dixon instructed to use feature numbers of R. Hall. However, ~~the~~ one feature (F. 2020 of T. Courtney) crosses boundary of CV and CVA. Thus, to use numbering of R. Hall, number F2020 throughout this feature. ~~F 1926 is equivalent to F. 2020 of T. Courtney.~~ All subsequent features in CVA use numbering of R. Hall (i.e. F 1926 onwards).

4.8.75 Continued removing layer (2) an earthy layer with small stones, to attempt to establish a more stony surface. The ditch F 2020 appears to extend down hill N. and E.

F 1926 A slight depression in the loose stone of layer (2) with some burned oolite. Approx centre AA 4.40 BB 5.30
