COMMENT

This wall is a poorly built one which rests upon the large collapse of the I.A. rampart (7605). Its own collapse of 7587 also rests upon 7605, and also has pushed down the upper courses of 7586 (Period 3b wall in ditch). The easterly facing slabs of this wall are thinner towards the S., and consist of larger blocks to the N.
