Good Edge, semicircular at Eastern end.

On Excavation of the eastern part along a N-S section this feature was found to be a broad, shallow pit, up to 45 cm deep, with vertical sides at North and South faces, and a

sloping roughly cut eastern end. [angle of slope about 60°].

Fill: — homogenous in consistency, about 50% medium sized stone, 50% light brown soil.

Layer ① distinguished by darker soil, and presence of some burnt stones.

Layer ② yellowish clayey leached soil, with rather fewer stones than ①. At bottom of ②, beneath northern edge, large number of fragmented? bones.

COMMENT

Note 3 small slots (planned) on S.E., N.W., and S.W. sides. c. 25 cm in depth.

420 Continues through natural fissure to S.W. as a shallow irregular gully sloping down into 420 proper [See main plan].
