From 35 cms down to approx 55 cms the walls gradually tapered inwards, then sharply curved to the base at 63 cms. The base of post hole ended in a fissure.

On excavation the entire North-East side of post hole was found to have a packed layer of grey oolite stones and decayed limestone from a depth of 30-35 cms to the base.
